

Aurora Wins Kane County Water Association's Annual Water Taste Test Contest

Thursday, December 18, 2008, Aurora took home the trophy for best tasting water in Kane County. All municipalities in Kane County were eligible, but Aurora won over the panel of judges: US99 radio host Ramblin' Ray Stevens, Lisa Jordan, Education Coordinator for the Illinois Section American Water Works Association, and a representative from The Courier News, Mike Danahey.

Water was distributed to the judges in unmarked beakers, so that they could not identify who's water they were drinking. Determining the best drinking water was based on taste, odor and clarity during the Kane County Water Association's annual water-tasting contest at Lincoln Inn Banquets in Batavia.

Aurora, along with Elburn, Geneva, Batavia, Sugar Grove, North Aurora, Elgin, Algonquin, Carpentersville and Montgomery participated in this year's contest.

Aurora will have bragging rights in Kane County and will represent the county in the state competition this upcoming March in Springfield.
